Dear Co- Laborers,

February was a short month, but full of blessings. I began the month by speaking at Aikin Grove M.B.C in Clarksville, Texas, where Bro. James Brown is pastor. After my time of fellowship with Aikin Grove, I began a Faith Promise Missions Revival with Macedonian Missionary Service's endorsing church, Nevill's Chapel M.B.C. of Mt. Pleasant, Texas, where Bro. Glenn Griffith is pastor.

There were many missionaries and pastors who attended. Evangelist Rex Newman preached a three night revival, all of the Macedonian missionaries gave reports, Bro. Brant Lane spoke Sunday morning, and I and a few others spoke in Sunday School class. The pastor and church were pleased with the outcome of the missions revival.

Soon after my return from Texas, I departed with the MacMed team, bound for Kenya, Africa. We started to work once again with Missionaries Ernie Hopper, Michael Hopper and Eddie Williams. The team worked in five different established churches along the Rift River Valley of Kenya near Lake Naivasha. All five churches were fully established, self-supporting churches that needed the encouragement that the MacMed team was able to give. There were 15 professions of faith, 900 patients treated, over 4,000 prescriptions filled and 275 pairs of glasses and sunglasses given.

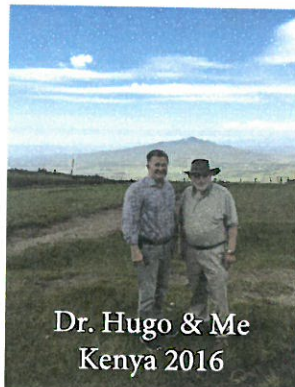
One of the highlights of my trip was taking part in the ordination service of two pastors. Missionary Michael Hopper and Bro. Glenn Griffith preached the message for the ordination service. We spent a day at the Masai Mara Game Park where we were able to see many different wild animals. We also spent some time at the tea plantation, enjoying the Lord's beautiful creation. Pastor James Muhanjis wife, Angeline passed away while we were there. She was in the hospital about 3 hours away from where we were staying. I took a taxi to go see her and pay my respects. In 1980 the Muhanji's were the first pastor family I met in Kenya, I am glad that I was there to see Angeline before her passing. The trip was a great blessing. God continues to do great things in Kenya.

We received word from Bro. Julio Anzora that the September MacMed campaign to El Salvador needs to be postponed to a later date. We will keep you updated on the rescheduling of that campaign.

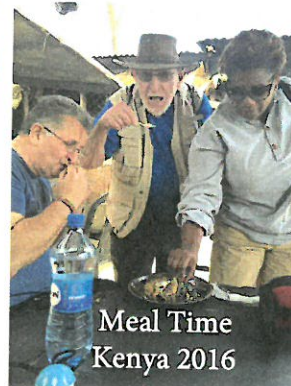
