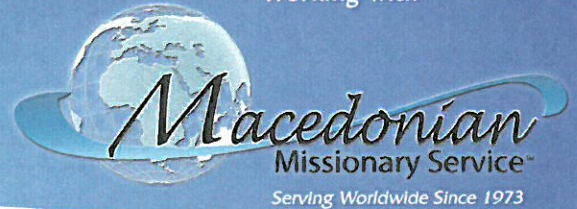


# Building Coordinator Paul Lamb
