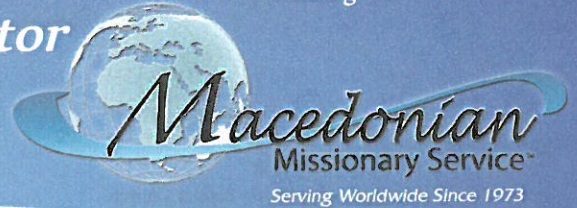

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

The month of March brought great weather to us in Georgia as spring time blossoms all around us. It's always a busy and special time of the year for us as we move into what many call the "Easter Season". We had the opportunity to see many new visitors at our home church, Hillcrest Baptist. Along with this, God brought many different people in our path that we had the opportunity to share the Gospel with.

We are blessed that most of our family lives close to us and we were able to get together during March to celebrate my mother's 81st birthday. Also our granddaughter, Emma turned 3; and we had a grand princess birthday party celebration.

I ask that you pray with us for my mother. She underwent a serious artery surgery in the last few weeks, and is recovering. She will face another surgery in the next several weeks. It has been a bit of a challenge since she is very independent, and she is used to doing whatever she pleases.

We have several vehicle projects in the works at this time. The van that is going to New Life Missionary Baptist Church, in Indiana in May is being finished up and planned to be delivered on May 21st-22nd.

Also, we have a 20 passenger bus in Kentucky that Bro. Terry Molden has checked out for us. It will be repaired and is going to New Mexico. Along with a van that Bro. Brant Lane was able to pickup with the Macedonian truck and trailer; he dropped it off at the shop in Acworth, GA. This van belongs to Alpha Omega Church, Pastor Gabriel Gregorio in Jacksonville, Arkansas. The van needs several items repaired to allow the mission to continue in its community ministry efforts. We will be picking up another van this month in Dothan, Alabama. The van was donated to be fixed up and passed on to a missionary in Colorado.

We are blessed to have these vehicles donated to be repaired and given to missionaries, but with this effort it cost money to make the necessary repairs to make them safe for us to pass them along to be used for the Lord's work. We will need to raise between \$2,500-\$3,000 for each van project. Please pray about how you or your church can help with these expenses and be a part of the Lord's work in this area.

Having the vans and buses to work on is a blessing. At the shop we have a lift that is not rated to lift these larger vehicles, and working on them with this lift is a little unsafe. Please pray with me that we can raise about \$7,000 to purchase and install a heavy duty lift to accommodate lifting and working on these vehicles that will be safer.
