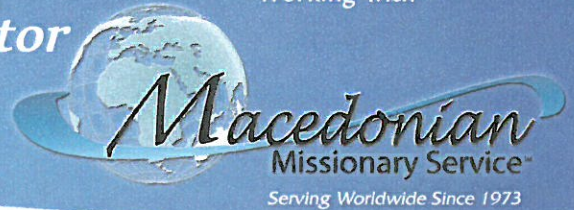

Brothers and Sisters,

The year 2016 continues to move along rapidly, it's hard to believe the year is already a third of the way gone by. April has kept us busy moving along with different projects.

The final repairs have been finished up on the van that will be going to Indiana. This van has required several hours of work along with many new parts, and most of the mechanical system rebuilt or replaced. I started off replacing the motor with a new 6.8L V10 from Ford. Along with all new ignition system, coolant system, the rear differential along with seals and bearings replaced. A completely new brake system with all new parts was installed. Along with the suspension rebuilt with new shocks, fuel lines, filters, fuel pump, exhaust system, new catalytic converter, steering column, bushings, several electrical issues repaired, and a new windshield installed. We are excited to hear report on this van usage as it is used in the Lord's work in Indiana. I will be delivering the van to New Life Missionary Baptist Church in Brownstown, Indiana on May 22, 2016.

Another van belonging to Alpha Omega Church in Jacksonville, Arkansas has been torn down in the shop and evaluated for needed repairs and service items. This van is going to require about \$2,500-\$3,000 in parts to complete repairs and return to the missionary church.

Brother's Arthur McIn along with Steve and Kelly Tarter drove from Somerset, Kentucky to Landmark Baptist Church in Dothan, Alabama to pick up a van that was donated by this church. After taking the van to Somerset, Kentucky for registration, they loaded up again the next week and headed to deliver the van to the shop in Acworth, Georgia. These men are a blessing to all of us at Macedonian Missionary Service, always willing to help.

Brother Terry Molden is working on a small passenger bus that is now in Nancy, Kentucky. This bus will be repaired and then taken and delivered to Brother Rusty Denny in New Mexico. I appreciate all of the work that Bro. Terry helps us all with. He is a blessing to so many using his talents for the Lord.

It was go good to see many of you in Kentucky at the Macedonian Banquet. We enjoy visiting with everyone, and being able to thank you in person for all of your support and encouragement.
